



PROVISIONAL ADMITTANCE

According to the New Jersey State Sanitary Code, Chapter 14, provisional admittance to school is based on medical verification indicating that at least one dose of each of the following vaccines has been administered and that full compliance is in process. The vaccines include:

- Diphtheria-Pertussis-Tetanus (DPT)
- Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV)
- Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR)
- Hepatitis B
- Varicella (Chicken Pox)
- Flu Shot (For all children under 5 years of age by 12/31 of starting year)

Documents accepted as evidence of a child's immunization history provided that the type of immunization and the date when each immunization was administered include:

- An official school record from any school, pre-school, or child care center indicating compliance;
- A record from any public health department indicating compliance;
- A certificate signed by a physician licensed to practice medicine or osteopathy or an advanced practice nurse (certified registered nurse practitioner, or clinical nurse specialist) in any jurisdiction of the United States;
- The official record of immunization from the New Jersey Immunization Information System.

All immunization records submitted by a parent or guardian in a language other than English shall be accompanied by a translation sufficient to determine compliance with the immunization requirements. Laboratory evidence of protective immunity, as enumerated by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) of the United States Public Health Service, shall be accepted as evidence of immunization if a parent or guardian cannot produce a documented history of immunization.

Upon enrollment into school:

- Each school district shall require parents to provide examination documentation of each student within 30 days of enrollment
- When a student is transferring to another school, each school district shall ensure that student documentation of entry examination is forwarded to the transfer school district pursuant to N.J.A.C.6A:16-2.4(d)
- Students transferring into a New Jersey school from out of state or out of country may be allowed a 30 day period in order to obtain entry examination documentation
